#### **RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

- Through the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), successfully
  passed 36 proposals including provisions for paid family leave, support for
  maternal health, and efforts to disrupt fentanyl trafficking
- Received the Legislative Action Award from the Bipartisan Policy Center
- Through the PACT Act, the Coatesville VA and Penn Medicine have agreed to a historic partnership to help modernize care for our veterans
- Authored the most comprehensive legislation to date to improve access to donor breast milk
- Reintroduced the bipartisan Mathematical and Statistical Modeling Education Act – The Science, Space, and Technology Committee marked up this legislation (passing unanimously) that would modernize K-12 STEM education
- Introduced bipartisan legislation to keep U.S. oil from our Strategic Petroleum Reserves from being sold to Chinese-affiliated companies and other sanctioned nations like Russia, North Korea, and Iran
- Nominated 32 students from PA-06 to our country's military academies in 2023 and a total of 122 students over the past five years

- Supported the Inflation Reduction Act, to lower the cost of prescription drugs by limiting out-of-pocket expenses to \$2,000/year and cap the price of insulin at \$35/month for Medicare recipients
- Increased mental health supports for students and comprehensive gun violence prevention through the Bipartisan Safer Communities Act
- Secured the initial \$750,000 (via Community Project Funding) needed to initiate studies for Philadelphia-Reading rail and voted for additional funding secured by IIJA for the Schuykill River Passenger Rail Authority
- Delivered on promise of bipartisanship by introducing 92% of bills in the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress with bipartisan support

## **DELIVERING CONSTITUENT SERVICES (Since January 2019)**

- \$56 million returned to constituents through casework services.
- 8,287 cases resolved for our community.
- 355,813 emails sent and 35,766 phone calls returned
